Proposal: Provide the patron the ability to sort the list of items they have out other than alphabetically. One patron requested the ability to sort by due date. Another sort might be author.

Subject: Refund on Individual Blocks
Proposal: Cannot refund on a specific credit block (for lost and returned item) if there is an amount owing on the borrower record as a whole (for other lost items). Often borrowers like to ``pay off`` particular items, so if they return a specific item that was lost they want a refund, even if further amounts are owing. Library should have option to allow this.

Subject: Inline Frame Scroll Bars
Proposal: When including a web page within HIP as an Inline frame, it should be possible to include javascript within HIP to autodetect the length of the page, from the same or a different domain. This will stop the ``scrollbar within scrollbar`` that appears when the wrapped page is longer than the pixel length supplied when setting up the channel for the inline frame. This is used successfully in applications such as the open source content management system Mambo (these pages are called a ``wrapper``)

Subject: HIP Bookmarking and Linking - URL problems
Proposal: 1. When people bookmark HIP, they invariably do so from a url which contains session information. Then when they return they receive a ``this channel failed to accept pcs`` message - or even following a link like this which happens when HIP is left open and refreshes:
http://catalogue.logan.qld.gov.au/uPortal/render.userLayoutRootNode.uP?startover=true&uP_reload_layout=true
 > this results in unnecessary calls to the library that the catalogue is not working.
 > even an ``add to favourites`` link on the home page with a clean url would help.
 2. Being unable to deep link is also a disadvantage, as this also creates the above error with channels failing to render.
 3. Switching between different profiles also causes confusion in the HIP templates. If I create a link to a branch profile from an external web page, and a Main profile for HIP exists, then the link goes to the Main profile, as no profile information is carried in the link variables.

Proposal: The borrower barcode on the patron record should display the active barcode first. As it is right now, sometimes a patron`s lost barcode will show first and this confuses our staff who neglect to look at the lost date. In general, it should be possible to specify an order for a blink.

Subcategory:**Software Version/Release:** 7.3.2**Subject:** ``Related Works`` Search in the Bibliographic Detail View for ``Added Authors`` When Having Multiple Authors**Proposal:** In the bibliographic detail view, when you have more than one author in the ``added author`` area, if you click on one, the whole area will be highlighted, and if you then click on ``related works``, Horizon would do a search for ALL authors in the ``added authors`` area and give you author-title lists for all added authors. But I am hoping to have just one author search returned. Is there a way not to have the whole ``added authors`` field highlighted, and only search the one author I click on? If there's only one author in the ``added author`` field, Horizon would do exactly that-- when clicking on ``related works``, it only returns you with one author-title list.

The problem also exists if you have multiple subjects in the subject area, the ``related works`` would always search for all subjects listed because the whole area is highlighted when you click on it.
