Subject: Importing Authority Records

Proposal: When it is necessary for Horizon to establish a system generated authority record for a 550 field contained in an authority record which is being imported, this authority record should be created without the \$w subfield in the 150 field. And when there is a \$w subfield in the original 550 field, which contains the data `g`, the resulting system generated record should NOT contain the original 150 field as a 550 field. The current situation turns all broader terms into related terms which is incorrect.

makes it crystal clear what's going on, very conveniently.

Subject: All Authority Searches Ignore Leading Articles

Proposal: Horizon always ignores articles when searching the catalog. There is no difference between an author search and a title search, the article is always ignored. The workaround for this is to enter article exceptions one at a time in the table editor. In Dynix, this was all accomplished through mapping. The idea of manual entry to the article exceptions list is not appealing because of the amount of exceptions that would need to be entered along with the constant maintenance. We would like authority searches to not ignore articles.

Subject: Accept 4XX Authority Headings Larger Than 255 Characters
